
The overall UCSF climate is viewed positively, by large majorities of staff, faculty and learners.


 70% say the climate at UCSF is "comfortable" or "very comfortable".




Experiences of exclusionary behavior vary across UCSF and are more common for historically underrepresented groups.

- Women (26%) more likely than men (19%) to experience.
- LGBQ+ (29%), trans/non-binary people (38%), and those with disabilities (38%) more likely to experience.
- Rates highest among Native American and Black/AA individuals.


Among those who experienced exclusionary behavior, position is the most frequent assumed basis, followed by race/ethnicity and gender.


At UCSF overall, there is variation by position in experience of exclusionary behavior.





More Black/African American and Native American individuals say they experience exclusionary behavior.
