The [UCSF Committee on the Status of Women](#) (CSW) is a broad based and inclusive committee charged with examining the issues regarding the status of women on this campus (excluding those involving wages, hours or working conditions); to analyze existing policies, procedures, and /or programs that affect those issues; to serve as a coordinating body for groups or individuals concerned with the status of women at UCSF; and to recommend to the Vice-Chancellor of Diversity and Outreach changes that will continue to afford women equal and fair access to campus programs and activities.

The committee is structured with three primary subcommittees (listed below) for members to serve on to organize and take action on efforts:

- **Policy & Advocacy:** Engages with leadership & works with the committee to clarify and determine what projects CSW takes on. Focuses on policy action and works with other subcommittees to effectively advocate and generate actions for change.
- **Events:** Creates tangible and interactive events that engage the community, generate awareness, and spark excitement about the work that CSW does. Many events are done in partnership with other groups or departments, this is a real opportunity to shape discussions around the important work that we do.
- **Communications:** Does vital work of connecting people with what we're doing. They're currently focused on developing CSW's online presence, but is also heavily involved in all aspects of the committee, including Membership, Events, and Policy & Advocacy.
